2. PRESENTATION:

• 2021 Budget Process Overview

Mr. Gant introduced CFO, Amy Spera; he then discussed the municipal budget process and planning; the goal is to introduce the budget at the April 14th meeting. Amy Spera thanked the Department Heads for their guidance; she commented that she is learning both the operational and capital needs to prepare the budget in conformity with their needs as well as Council.

• Crescent Park Racquet Sports Recreation Area

Mr. D'Altrui presented an update on Crescent Park addressing the needs of a second paddle ball court and the concerns of light, noise, trees and parking.

Mayor Farrell joined the meeting at 8:20 pm.

Borough Attorney, Ray Bogan addressed the Sea Girt Forest Stewardship Plan; he commented there is a provision that deals with Landowner Management Goals: to maintain forest cover for the enjoyment and passive recreational use of local residents. Council can take action notwithstanding the fact, but recommends strongly revisiting the Sea Girt Forest Stewardship Plan if action is taken.

Resolution No. 40-2021

Authorize Participation in the 36th Annual Clean Ocean Action Spring and Fall Beach Sweeps, Saturday, April 17th and the Fall Beach Sweeps on Saturday, October 23rd from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm; subject to submission of Certificate of Insurance naming the Borough as an additional insured;

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Girt has participated in helping the volunteer organization Clean Ocean Action in the past and would like to continue to do so; and,

WHEREAS, the organization is requesting permission to perform spring and fall clean-up at the Borough of Sea Girt's beaches; and,

WHEREAS, a Beach Captain is assigned by Clean Ocean Action to lead the clean-up site and will help organize the clean-up at the Borough's beach and direct volunteers at the event, and ensure the proper collection, categorizing and separation of the debris.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Girt, does hereby authorize the following Beach Sweeps on April 17 and October 23, 2021 from 9:00am to 12:30 pm, respectively, subject to the following:

- 1. Clean Ocean Action will provide a Beach Captain to help organize the clean-up, direct volunteers and ensure proper collection by categorizing and separating debris, and
- 2. The Beach Captain will coordinate with the Public Works Department Manager before the event to make the necessary trash pick-up and recycling arrangements.
- 3. Clean Ocean Action shall provide to the Borough of Sea Girt a Certificate of Insurance naming the Borough of Sea Girt as an additional insured with General Liability Insurance in the amount of a Combined Single Limit of \$1,000,000.00; proof of said policy shall be provided to the Borough prior to April 9, 2021.
- 4. Volunteers will not be permitted in the closed areas of the beach in order to protect the nesting grounds of endangered species.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be supplied to Clean Ocean Action, Michael McArthur and Chief Macko for their information.

Resolution No. 41-2021

Authorize the Signing of an Agreement with Sea Girt 5k, Inc. Allowing or the Conduct of a Foot Race on August 7, 2021, Waiving Noise Ordinance and Imposing Parking Restrictions in Connection Therewith;

WHEREAS, in previous years the Borough of Sea Girt, a Municipal Corporation of the State of New Jersey, entered into Agreements with the Sea Girt 5K, Inc., a 501(c)3 corporation of the State of New Jersey, for the sponsorship of a 5K race; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Sea Girt recognize the benefit of this special event to residents of and visitors to the Borough of Sea Girt; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Recreation Commissioners of the Borough of Sea Girt, has determined that in order to provide funds, in whole or part, necessary to improve, maintain and police the playgrounds or recreation places under its control, it would be beneficial to jointly sponsor the Sea Girt 5K run on August 7, 2021; and.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council and Sea Girt 5K, Inc. wish to enter into an Agreement to jointly conduct the Sea Girt 5K in 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as follows:

- 1. Sea Girt 5K, Inc. will conduct the foot race to be held on August 7, 2021, not to exceed five kilometers, as well as children's races, live music and activities; if these events are permitted under Executive Orders issued by the Governor;
- 2. Sea Girt 5K, Inc. will provide acceptable insurance and a release to the Borough having the Borough named as additional insured against liability and property damage for the purpose of the event. Sea Girt 5K, Inc. shall deliver to the Borough prior to the event a

- certificate evidencing minimum coverage in the amounts of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence.
- 3. Sea Girt 5K, Inc. will provide evidence satisfactory to the Borough that it is a validly organized not-for-profit corporation of the State of New Jersey and will be so as of the date of the event.
- 4. The Borough of Sea Girt will permit the use of its roadways, provide police, emergency, and public works department assistance and provide insurance under the terms of its general liability insurance policy on August 7, 2021, the day of the race.
- 5. Sea Girt 5K, Inc. will pay over to the Borough of Sea Girt not less than 90% of the participation fees in the 5K Run/Walk and not less than 90% of the participation fees in the Kids' Races.
- 6. The net proceeds of the entry fees collected by Sea Girt 5K, Inc. after deduction of the expenses set forth in Section 5, above shall be retained by the Sea Girt 5K, Inc. for use and or charitable donations to be made in the sole discretion of Sea Girt 5K, Inc.
- 7. The Sea Girt Noise Ordinance is hereby waived between the hours of 7:30 AM to 8:00 AM, inclusive, on August 7, 2021.
- 8. The Sea Girt Police Department shall create a 'No Parking' Zone at the Plaza and along Washington Blvd. to Sixth Avenue from Midnight through 12:00 Noon, inclusive, on August 7, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Girt-awarded a contract in the amount of \$295,625.25 to Jo-Med Contracting Corp., Elizabeth, NJ for the Project known as Carriage Way Water System Improvements April 15, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, field changes resulted in a net decrease in the contract in the amount of \$80,908.20 to the project resulting in the new contract total of \$214,717.42; and,

WHEREAS, the Project is completed and the Contractor has submitted the Request for Final Payment in the amount of \$22,261.96 and the required Maintenance Bond of \$53,679.36 .00 that has been reviewed by the Project Engineer and found to be correct.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Borough of Sea Girt as follows:

Resolution No. 47-2021

Authorizing the Borough of Sea Girt through the Sea Girt Police Department to Participate in the Defense Logistics Agency, Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO), 1033 Program to Enable the Sea Girt Police Department to Request and Acquire Excess Department of Defense Equipment, 1/1/2021 through 12/31/2021, inclusive;

WHEREAS, the United States Congress authorized the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) 1033 Program to make use of excess Department of Defense personal property by making that personal property available to municipal, county and State law enforcement agencies (LEAs); and

WHEREAS, DLA rules mandate that all equipment acquired through the 1033 Program remain under the control of the requesting LEA; and

WHEREAS, participation in the 1033 Program allows municipal and county LEAs to obtain property they might not otherwise be able to afford in order to enhance community preparedness, response, and resiliency; and

WHEREAS, although property is provided through the 1033 Program at no cost to municipal and county LEAs, these entities are responsible for the costs associated with delivery, maintenance, fueling, and upkeep of the property, and for specialized training on the operation of and acquired property; and

WHEREAS, N.J.SA. 40A:5-30.2 requires that the governing body of the municipality or county approve, by a majority of the full membership, both enrollment in, and the acquisition of any property through, the 1033 Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FUHTER RESOLVED that Sea Girt Police Department is hereby authorized to acquire items of non-controlled property designated "DEMILA," which may include office supplies, office furniture, computers, electronic equipment, generators, field packs, non-military vehicles, clothing, traffic signal systems, exercise equipment, moving equipment, storage devices and containers, tools, medical and first aid equipment and supplies, construction materials, lighting supplies,

beds and sleeping mats, wet and cold weather equipment and supplies, respirators, binoculars and other supplies or equipment of a non-military nature identified the LEA, if it shall become available in the period of time for which this resolution authorized, based on the needs of the Sea Girt Police Department, without restriction; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURHTER RESOLVED, that Sea Girt Police Department is hereby authorized to acquire the following "DEMIL B through Q" property, if it shall become available in the period of time for which this resolution authorized specifically being replacements parts as needed for the up-armored Humvee presently in service; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sea Girt Police Department shall develop and implement a full training plan and police for the maintenance and use of the acquired property; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sea Girt Police Department shall provide a quarterly accounting of all property obtained through the 1033 Program which shall be available to the public upon request; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately and shall be valid to authorize requests to acquire "DEMIL A" property and "DEMIL B through Q" property that may be made available through the 1033 Program during the period of time for which this resolution authorized; with Program participation and all property request authorization terminating on December 31st of the current calendar year from January 1, 2021.

Resolution No. 48-2021

Authorize an Open Public Records Information Management Shared Services Agreement with the County of Monmouth (RIMS);

WHEREAS, under the New Jersey Uniform Shared Services Consolidation Act, namely C. 40A:65-1, et seq., local units, such as the County of Monmouth and Sea Girt Borough, may enter into shared services agreements with each other; and

WHEREAS, the County of Monmouth has entered into an agreement with Sunrise Systems, Inc. ("Sunrise"), whereby the County is licensed to access and use Sunrise's web-based system known as the Open Public Records Search System – Records Information Management ("OPRS-RIM"); and

WHEREAS, under the terms of its agreement with Sunrise, the County of Monmouth may sublicense access and use of OPRS-RIM to municipalities/boards of education within Monmouth County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Monmouth, has offered to enter into a shared services agreement with Sea Girt Borough whereby this municipality/board of education will be authorized as a sublicensee to access and use OPRS-RIM; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the agreement is attached to this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the OPRS-RIM provides for the Inventory Management, Retention Management, and Disposition Management of official records and includes an imaging module that permits the scanning of paper records into TIFF images, which may be stored long-term, searched and retrieved electronically.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Sea Girt Borough that the Superintendent and Business Administrator be and they are hereby authorized to enter into the proposed OPRS-RIM shared services agreement with the County of Monmouth.

Resolution No. 52–2021 Approve Shared Service of Tax Assessor, Scott Kineavy

Councilwoman Giegerich commented this is a positive move for Sea Girt, new office hours for our Tax Assessor are Thursday between 2 – 5 pm.

UPON MOTION of Councilwoman Anthony, seconded by Councilwoman Giegerich, carried, that the following Resolution be and the same is hereby adopted:

THIS SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT, made this 11th day of March, 2021 (the "Agreement") by and between the Township of Aberdeen, with offices located at 1 Aberdeen Square, Aberdeen Township, NJ 07747, and the Borough of Sea Girt, located at 321 Baltimore Blvd, Sea Girt, NJ 08750 (the "Parties").

WITNESSETH:

- WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq., (the "Act") permits units of local government to share services for particular purposes and to effectuate agreements for any service or circumstance that will aid and encourage a reduction of local expenses; and
- WHEREAS, the Township of Aberdeen ("Aberdeen") and the Borough of Sea Girt ("Sea Girt") are public bodies corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey and are authorized under New Jersey law to enter into a Shared Services Agreement pursuant to the Act; and
- WHEREAS, Aberdeen has a Tax Assessor, who will perform the duties of municipal tax assessor for the parties, as permitted by law; and
 - NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereto, intending to be legally bound hereby, agree as follows:
- Section 1.01. <u>Designation of General Agent.</u> The Parties acknowledge that the Tax Assessor shall be an employee of Aberdeen for payment of any and all benefits with respect to that employee.
- Section 1.02 Responsibility. The Tax Assessor, having been duly appointed by Aberdeen pursuant to state law shall perform all statutory duties required of a municipal tax assessor and shall from time to time, when called upon by Sea Girt for at least one (1) day per week (Thursday) for three (3) hours (2:00PM 5:00PM) shall act as Tax Assessor for Sea Girt. In addition, the Tax Assessor shall be available for tax appeals. All records related to assessments or related property data for the Borough of Sea Girt shall be maintained so as to be accessible to authorized representative(s) of the Borough of Sea Girt, as designated by the Borough Council.
- Section 1.03 Costs and Fees. The Parties specifically agree that Sea Girt will pay Aberdeen a total of \$19,876.70 for 2021 with a 2% increase per year. 2021 will be paid on a pro-rata schedule.
- Section 1.04 <u>Term.</u> This Agreement shall take effect March 1, 2021 or a date to be agreed upon for a three (3) year period and shall be reviewed on an annual basis, which Agreement may be terminated at the end of a calendar year by any Party by providing written notice of termination no later than September 1st of the calendar year in which the Shared Services Agreement will terminate. Notices shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, in accordance with Section 1.11 hereof.
- Section 1.05 Covenants. The Parties represent and warrant, each to the other, that they are corporations duly organized, validly existing and in good standing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and have the authority and power to enter into and to carry out the terms and provisions of this Agreement. Each Party represents that the Agreement has been authorized by resolutions of the governing bodies of Aberdeen and Sea Girt.
- Section 1.06 <u>Insurance</u>. The Parties shall provide worker's compensation insurance for their employees as required by law. The Parties shall maintain comprehensive general liability in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$1,000,000.00 in the aggregate during the term of the Agreement and each shall name the other as an additional insured on such general liability policy. The Parties shall provide each other with Certificates of Insurance showing evidence of such coverage.

Section 1.07 <u>Indemnification</u>. Sea Girt is solely responsible for any liability, costs of litigation, fees & damages, arising out of or in any way related or connected to any assessment services or negligence resulting from this Agreement and any services delivered hereunder arising from any assessment, or negligent actions while performing services, for the Borough of Sea Girt. Sea Girt shall, hold Aberdeen and its officers, employees, agents and Tax Assessor harmless and defend and pay all costs, expenses, fees and damages, at its sole cost and expense, from any claims, in any administrative or judicial proceeding arising from, related to or in connection with this Agreement.

Section 1.08 Relationship of the Parties. Except as otherwise explicitly provided herein, no Party to this Agreement shall have any responsibility whatsoever with respect to services that are to be provided or contractual obligations that are to be assumed by the other Party and nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to constitute any Party an officer, employee, agent or legal representative of any other Party or to create any fiduciary relationship between or among the Parties. The Tax Assessor shall not gain tenure through or for the Borough of Sea Girt as a result of this agreement, or for his services to the Borough of Sea Girt.

Section 1.09. Waiver. The waiver by either party of a default or of a breach of any provision of this Agreement by the other party shall not operate or be construed to operate as a waiver of any subsequent default or breach. The making or the acceptance of a payment by either party with knowledge of the existence of a default or breach shall not operate or be construed to operate as a waiver of any subsequent default or breach.

Section 1.10. <u>Modification</u>. Modifications, waivers or amendments of this Agreement shall be effective only if set forth in a written instrument signed by both Parties hereto after all required actions regarding the authorization for such modifications, waivers or amendments have been taken.

Section 1.11 Notices. Any notice or other communication required to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been validly given if emailed, delivered in person or via overnight or certified mail, postage prepaid, addressed as follows:

Changes in the respective addresses to which such notices may be directed may be made from time to time by any party by written notice to the other party.

Section 1.12 <u>Assignment of Rights</u>. Neither party shall assign, sell, transfer or otherwise vest in any person any of its rights or obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other party, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld.

Section 1.13 <u>Successors and Assigns</u>. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the respective subsidiaries, successors and permitted assigns of the Parties hereto.

Section 1.14 Severability. In the event that any provision of this Agreement shall, if for any reason, be determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect by any court of competent jurisdiction the Parties hereto shall negotiate in good faith and agree to such amendments, modifications or supplements of or to this Agreement or to such other appropriate actions as shall, to the maximum extent

practicable in light of such determination, implement and give effect to the intentions of the Parties as reflected herein. Notwithstanding such determination, such determination shall not invalidate or render any other provision hereof unenforceable.

Section 1.15 Governing Law. The obligations of the Parties hereunder shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

Section 1.16 <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts with the same effect as if the signature and seals thereto and hereto were upon the same instrument.
