



Cat Licensing Information

If your cat's rabies shot expires before November 1, 2012, you must get your cat a new rabies shot before we can release your 2012 cat license to you.

Proof of Rabies Inoculation is required for issuance of a license and registration tag; Rabies Vaccination Requirement: N.J.S.A. 4:19-15-3a required that the duration of the immunity extends throughout at least the first ten (10) months of the twelve (12) month licensing period.

A person applying for a cat license and registration tag shall pay a fee of five (\$5.00) dollars for each spayed or neutered cat and eight (\$8.00) dollars for each non-spayed or non-neutered cat. Owners presenting a certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian certifying that their cat has been sterilized are exempt from the three (\$3.00) dollar surcharge.

Registration tags and renewals thereof shall expire on January 31st of each year. A late fee of five (\$5.00) dollars shall be assessed if a renewal fee is paid after March 31st.

You may obtain your cat license either by mail or in person at the Sea Girt Borough Hall, 321 Baltimore Boulevard, Sea Girt, NJ.

Please make checks payable to Sea Girt Borough and include a self address envelope. You must include Proof of Rabies Vaccination. If your cat has been spayed or neutered, you must also include this proof with your application.
