

# BOROUGH OF SEA GIRT 2012 SANITATION AND RECYCLING SCHEDULE

*NOTE: This is an interim schedule as there will be recycling changes in the early part of the year.  
Please read carefully as significant changes take effect in 2012.*

**This schedule is effective as of March 1, 2012**

## RECYCLE YARD

**Location:** Wall Recycling Center, Atlantic Avenue, Wall Township

**Hours:** Monday to Saturday 8:00am to 3:00 pm  
Closed on Sunday and Holidays

- The Wall Yard has one bin for recyclables: Commingled, Newspapers, Magazines/Junk Mail, Cardboard, Brush and Metals. Wall accepts any plastic products that are recyclable from 1 to 7.

## RECYCLING PICK UP

**Winter/Spring Schedule: Jan 9 to May 16\***

**Zone 1 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the Month:** The Terrace to Baltimore Blvd

**Zone 2 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the Month:** Philadelphia Blvd to Sea Girt Ave

**Summer Schedule: May 23 to Sept. 5\***

**Zone 1 & Zone 2 Every Wednesday of the Month**

**Fall/Winter Schedule: Sept. 12 to Jan 6, 2013\***

**Zone 1 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the Month:** The Terrace to Baltimore Blvd

**Zone 2 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the Month:** Philadelphia Blvd to Sea Girt Ave

**On Months that have five Wednesdays:** The 5<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the Month will be both Zone 1 & 2.

*\*Unless otherwise noted in the Holiday schedule*

All recyclables will be picked up curbside or backyard (resident's choice) on your designated Wednesday unless otherwise noted in the Holiday Schedule.

## COMMINGLE RECYCLABLES:

Bottles, newspapers, junk mail, cardboard, and cans may be commingled in open containers no larger than 30 gallons. Containers must have holes in the bottom to drain off liquids and rainwater.

## BOTTLES & CANS:

Includes aluminum cans, tin and bi-metal cans, glass bottles and jars, plastic "pourable containers". EXCLUDE foil, pie tins, trays, cookware, dishware, light bulbs, ceramics and window glass. Be sure to empty any container used for automotive fluids.

## SHREDDED or MIXED PAPER:

Includes letterhead, colored and white paper, junk mail, soft cover books, chipboard (e.g., cereal boxes).

All paper should be in a clear bag for pick-up. Styrofoam packing (peanuts) should be bagged and put with household trash.

## HAZARDOUS WASTE – NOT ACCEPTED:

Paint, chemicals, fertilizers, leftover chemicals in containers etc., must be taken to the Monmouth County Household Hazardous Waste Facility. *Call 732-922-2234 for an appointment.*

**LEAVES - CURBSIDE PICK-UP: April 15 to May 15 and October 15 to December 15.**

Leaves are to be raked to the gutter. Piles of leaves should **not** be within 15 feet of a storm drain.

For safety reasons, piles of leaves should **not** be placed on Rt. 71 or less than 15 ft. from the intersection of any road and Rt. 71.

**Do not mix grass, flowers or branches in the leaves.**

**GARDEN TRASH PICK UP**

**January to March:** January 23, February 27 and March 19

**April to December:** Every Monday. If a holiday falls on a Monday, pick up will be on Tuesday. Garden trash is to be placed at the curb (the area between the sidewalk and curb) **after** 6:00 pm the preceding Sunday **in open containers no greater than 50 lbs**; 4 can limit; Branches are to be in bundles **no larger than** 4 feet by 2 feet. **There is no grass or topsoil pick up.**

**BULK DAYS**

**Clean Up Days: Jan 9, Feb 6, Mar 5, Apr 23, June 11, Aug. 13, Oct 15 and Nov 5**

Disposable household items should be placed at the curb after 6:00 pm the preceding Saturday. Doors must be removed from washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc. We will **not** pick up automobile parts, tires, building materials, tree stumps, chemicals, paints or concrete blocks, bricks, etc.

**HOUSEHOLD TRASH DAYS**

**Winter Schedule: Jan 9 to Apr 29\***

**Zone 1 Thursday:** The Terrace to Baltimore Blvd

**Zone 2 Tuesday:** Philadelphia Blvd to Sea Girt Ave

**Summer/Fall Schedule: Apr 30 to Jan 6, 2013 \***

**Zone 1 Monday and Thursday:** The Terrace to Baltimore Blvd

**Zone 2 Tuesday and Friday:** Philadelphia Blvd to Sea Girt Ave

***\*Unless otherwise noted in the Holiday schedule***

Trash should be easily accessible and secured in bags (loose trash in a can will not be accepted) for 7:00 am pick up. The men are not allowed to enter garages, sheds or homes to collect trash. Metal cans and bungee cords deter animals.

**WINTER TRASH COLLECTION**

In the event of snow, trash may be placed at the curb. Trash will be picked up in the back yard only if there is a walkway free from snow and ice.
