8. Tree Donation Program Update: On Nov. 12th, 2022, the Recreation Commission participated with the Shade Tree Commission and Sea Girt Conservancy in the 2nd installment of our tree planting donation program. A total of 20 trees were planted in Edgemere Park and on the peninsula on route 71 at Beacon Blvd. A total of \$10,000 was donated by residents and the Rec Commission through the matching gift tree program. Over 30 trees were planted last spring in Crescent Park in an area previously cleared of invasive vines by a joint volunteer clean up. So far, the Shade Tree Commission has used \$7060.96 of the \$10,000. 51 trees have been planted. \$2939 is remaining for a Spring 2023 planting with details to follow.
