

Use of Signs (Residential and Commercial)

Ordinance 579:

All uses, whether by variance or as permitted use, shall comply with the provisions of the subsection of Ordinance 579 – Signs. Signs shall be attached to buildings, or if freestanding, the setback shall be at least ten (10) feet and sufficient so as to not interfere with the public right-of-way. No sign of any type shall be permitted obstruct driving vision, traffic signals and signs, and other places or business. For more details, see the Schedule of Limitations in Ordinance 579.
