- **Certification of 2016 Recycling Tax paid, \$3,047.73;**

**WHEREAS**, the Recycling Enhancement Act, P.L. 2007, C.311, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grants may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and,

**WHEREAS**, there is levied upon the owner or operator of every solid waste facility (with certain exceptions) a recycling tax of \$3.00 per ton on all solid waste accepted for disposal or transfer at the solid waste facility; and,

**WHEREAS**, whenever a municipality operates a municipal service system for solid waste collection, or provides for regular solid waste collection service under a contract awarded pursuant to the "Local Public Contracts Law", the amount of grant monies received by the municipality shall not be less

than the annual amount of recycling tax paid by the municipality except that all grant monies received by the municipality shall be expended only for its recycling program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Borough of Sea Girt that the Borough of Sea Girt hereby certifies submission of expenditure for taxes paid pursuant to P.L. 2007, C.311, in 2016 in the amount of \$3,047.73. **6. OLD BUSINESS**

A. **Ordinance No. 02-2017** – public hearing/possible adoption

Mayor Farrell read the said Ordinance by title advising of its publication in its entirety in *The Coast Star* on March 9, 2017 and explained that the original intent of the Ordinance was to minimize traffic on the road in anticipation of the major rehabilitation project scheduled to begin this Spring. Since the introduction, the Borough has received information from the County that there are obstructions in the sight lines at First Avenue, so the recommendation is not to adopt the Ordinance and the Borough will explore other alternatives; however, the public hearing will proceed as advertised.

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER VII, TRAFFIC, ARTICLE 7-20 STOP INTERSECTIONS; ARTICLE 7-23 ONE WAY STREETS; ARTICLE 7-26 TURN PROHIBITIONS OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEA GIRT, MONMOUTH COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Sea Girt as follows:

**Section 1.** Article 7-20. STOP INTERSECTIONS is hereby revised as follows:

**Section 3.** Article 7-26 TURN PROHIBITIONS is hereby supplemented and amended as follows:

**Section 3.** No debt is to be issued for said improvement and the cost of said improvement is to be financed from the funds presently accumulated in the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough of Sea Girt to the extent of \$6,950.00

**Section 4. Repeal, Severability.**

a. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

b. If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

- a. **Beach News** – Beach badge registration is now open - for 2017, *this is an on-line process only*.   - b. **Shade Tree News** – the Borough's Shade Tree Commission is participating in the DEP's Sandy Tree Recovery Program and will be distributing free bare root seedlings of various species' to residents on Saturday, May 8 from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM from the school parking lot and to our SGES students on May 10 through the school. Planting directions will be distributed with the seedlings, but the trees must be planted within 48 hours of receipt. The seedlings are for planting on private property (they are *not* suitable apron trees). Further information will be provided in the next few weeks.
  - c. **Other** – Tickets are now on sale for the Borough's September 9, 2017 "Once in our Lifetime" Centennial Celebration including a parade with children's activities immediately following at Baltimore Park and an evening of dinner and dancing under tents on the grounds of the NGTC.   - d. **Dune Walkover – Neptune Blvd.** – At a meeting held earlier this year, the Mayor had requested feedback on whether Council should consider changing the configuration of the Neptune walkover. The current configuration is consistent with the DEP's regulations regarding the construction of walkover structures and with only a one foot difference in the width between the existing structure and the one that was offered as a comparison, the benefit is not substantial enough to justify the addition costs necessary to reconfigure the structure.

Kayaks are prohibited from being launched on North Beach from March 15<sup>th</sup> until notification from the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife and approval by the Beach Manager or Chief Lifeguard. Kayaks may be launched north of Trenton Beach bathing area daily, subject to safe surf conditions. Storage bins are available for rental for kayaks or other beach items from Memorial Day to one week after Labor Day. The fee is \$200; on-line registration is required and may be renewed this year through June 19. One kayak or storage locker per family as space is limited. The launching of kayaks on North Beach shall be in accordance with and subject to areas so designated by the Beach Manager/Chief Lifeguard to avoid interference with the Endangered and Protected Species Activity and Habitat.

#### RESTROOMS

**K-1** The Pavilion restrooms will be open during normal beach hours and during special events at the beach.

#### DOGS ON BOARDWALK AND BEACH

**L-1** Borough Ordinance No. 485 prohibits dogs on the boardwalk. Dogs are not permitted on the beach from March 15 to September 30 of any year. At other times of the year any owner or a person having custody or control of a dog may be on the beach only if the dog is securely confined and controlled by an adequate leash not more than six (6) feet in length. The requirements of Ordinance No. 485, Section A7 requiring clean up after any dog are hereby made applicable to the public beach area. Your explicit cooperation in the observance of this ordinance is requested.

#### BICYCLE RIDING

**M-1** Riding or standing bicycles on the boardwalk from May 15 to September 15 is restricted to the hours of 5:00 am to 9:00 am. Motorized vehicles are not permitted at any time on the beach or boardwalk. Skates and skateboards are not permitted at any time on the boardwalk.

**N-2** Any person or persons violating any of the foregoing rules and regulations may be prosecuted in accordance with Borough Ordinance No. 17-2010.

#### NO SMOKING ON BEACH AND BOARDWALK

**O-1** No person shall smoke a cigar, cigarette, pipe or otherwise use tobacco products or vape on the beachfront, boardwalk, beach or boardwalk access pathway at any time (Ordinance No. 10-2014)

## 2017 BEACH REGULATIONS

Adopted pursuant to Borough Ordinance #17-2010, as amended, regulating the use of bathing beaches.

#### DUNE GRASS AND DUNE PRESERVATION

Great expense and effort went into planting of the dune grass, planted to preserve the dunes and protect our coast line. *Please respect your beach and keep off the dunes.* No person may walk or enter upon a protected dune area (Ordinance No. 543)

#### ENDANGERED-PROTECTED SPECIES CONSERVATION

The Borough of Sea Girt places special emphasis on the protection and conservation of Endangered-Protected Species. We would ask that all of the guests to our beach also be cognizant of this and support our efforts. We would like to encourage you to advise our lifeguards if you see anything of concern as relates to an Endangered-Protected Species. Thank you for visiting our beach.

#### BEACH BADGES & FOOD/TRASH INFORMATION

**A-1** Each and every person (except children under 12 years of age) must have beach badge when using any of the beaches in Sea Girt during posted open hours. This badge shall be displayed on your person in a prominent place at all times.

**A-2** Beach badges may be obtained between the hours of 9:00am and 4:00pm at the Bathing Pavilion Office at the foot of Beacon Boulevard or at other designated areas along the beachfront. Cash, checks or credit card purchases are available at the Pavilion. Cash **only** for purchases at the gates.

**A-3** Lifeguards are on duty daily, 9:15 am to 4:45 pm from June 17 through September 4 at designated beaches and from 9:15 am to 5:45 pm weekends starting May 27, 2017.

**A-4** Lost or misplaced beach badges will not be replaced.

**A-5** On-line registration is required for seasonal badges purchase via credit card at \$105.00 per badge for the season. **Senior Badges** (age 65 or older) are available at \$55.00 per badge, with proper identification; they have a distinctive pattern and are for use by seniors only. Badges are required from Memorial Day weekend and weekends thereafter through June 18, 2017. **Badges are required every day from June 19 until September 4, 2017, inclusive.**

**A-6** Daily Badges are required for the same days as seasonal and are available for \$10.00 per person. These badges can be purchased at the Main Pavilion and other designated areas (cash only) along the beachfront.

**A-7** Food on the beach is prohibited. Only non-alcoholic beverages in non-disposable containers are permitted on the beach. The throwing, dumping or placing of cans, bottles, containers, papers, food or other waste or refuse material on the beach is prohibited.

**A-8** Garbage and recycling containers are located on the boardwalk area. Please use the appropriate container for trash disposal.
